

ACH (online giving) at St. Maurice;

An account was recently set up with Vision Bank of Fargo where you have an opportunity to make electronic giving from your bank account to the St. Maurice Church's account. This service is provided as a convenience for those who prefer to do electronic transactions. Other than the convenience for those who prefer not to use envelopes or write checks, online giving helps to balance out the income to the church since there is less attendance at weekend services during summer months.

If you choose to use electronic giving, Earl will work with you to set up your account; there is a Consumer Authorization form which you will need to fill out and provide for registration. **Be assured that any and all information you provide is confidential and secure.** It is our intention to begin using this service in April; transactions will be once a month with the day of transfer on the 16th of the month or the first business day after the 16th if that day falls on a weekend or holiday.

ND SMP Scam of the Month – May New Medicare cards will be arriving soon!


What do I need to know about my new Medicare card? **YOU DO NOT NEED TO DO ANYTHING!!**

As long as your current address is correct, the new cards will automatically be mailed to North Dakota beneficiaries beginning after June 2018 through April 2019.

Your new card will be mailed in an envelope that looks like the example below.

If you believe Social Security does not have your current address, call 1-800-773-1213 or visit My Social Security account at <https://www.ssa.gov/myaccount/> and verify or change your current mailing information.

Watch out for scams? Scam artists may try to get personal information (like your current Medicare number) by contacting you about your new card. If someone asks for your personal information or threatens to cancel your health benefits if you don't share the information, **HANG UP** and call ND SMP at 1-800-233-1737 or Medicare at 1-800-633-4227.
